Our 6 Main Programs






MOBILE CARE CLINIC

Our mobile clinic brings direct primary healthcare services to the hard-to-reach areas on our Island. Providing immunizations, TB skin tests, women's health care, and physical exams to the uninsured and underinsured population.

Outreach and engagement activities to build relationships in the community for mutual support. TGF continues to utilize our Mobile Care Clinic program to deliver TB education and awareness, as well as promote screening in high-risk populations. Our partnership with the local Public Health TB Program allows us to bridge the gap in lack of community education and screening, and case management of active TB cases, while TGF continues our Mobile Clinic operations of LTBI treatment and screening.
