

## **HEPATITIS B**

Hepatitis B (Hep B) is a virus transmitted through blood contact or sex. Most people get it at birth.

It is possible to get Hep B from having unprotected sex, sharing personal care items (razors or toothbrushes), used needles or ritual circumcision.

### **HEALTHY LIVER**

Your liver keeps you alive, it cleans toxins from your blood, and makes energy for your body.
With Hep B, the liver can't do its job.

## SCARRING OF THE LIVER

Hep B is a virus that attacks the liver. Most people don't feel sick, and don't know their liver is getting damaged.

# SEVERE LIVER DAMAGE

Hep B can get worse over time. Symptoms can take 30 years to show, and are often a sign of advanced liver disease.

#### LIVED CANCER


Hep B can lead to liver cancer. The only way of surviving liver cancer is surgery or transplant.
