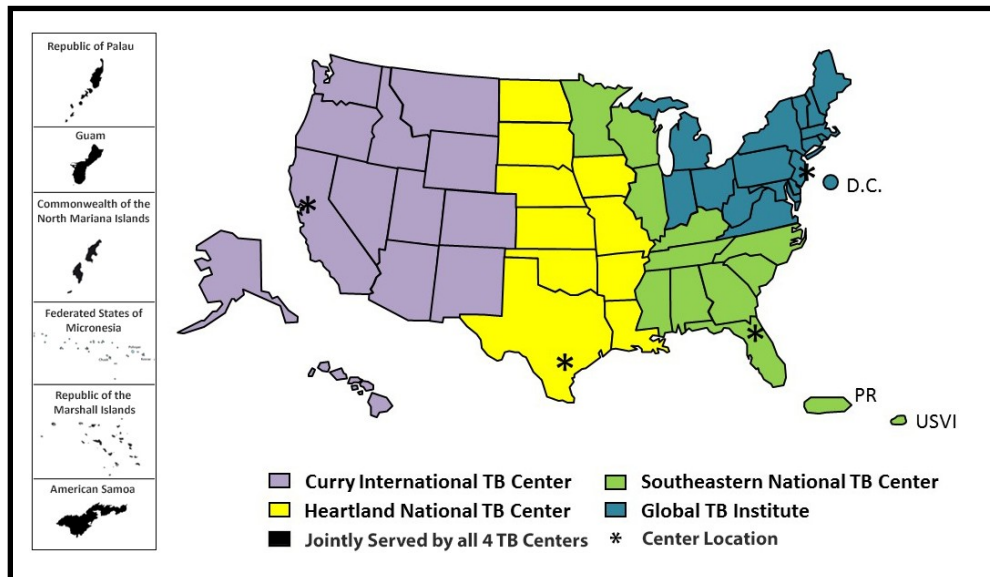


CITC Update for 2021 TB Elimination Alliance (TEA) Summit

- CITC was founded in 1994 and is part of the University of California, San Francisco. Currently funded from 2018-2022 as a Tuberculosis Center of Excellence for Training, Education, and Medical Consultation (TB COE) for the western region, serving 17 jurisdictions
